GLIDE Temporarily Closed for 3 Days in Order to Conduct a Precautionary Facilities Deep Cleaning to Further Protect Public Health

Beginning today (March 13), GLIDE is temporarily pausing its services for 3 days in order to conduct a precautionary facilities deep cleaning to further protect public health.

We are taking this step in an abundance of caution, given the current public health crisis. GLIDE is temporarily closing its physical doors at 330 Ellis Street through the weekend, and re-opening on Monday morning in order to conduct a preventative deep cleaning of its facilities.

GLIDE is working with community partners to ensure that San Francisco's most vulnerable continue getting the services they need.

At the same time, Thursday's decision by the San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD) to close San Francisco schools for the next three weeks means that GLIDE's Janice Mirikitani Family, Youth and Childcare Center (at 434 Ellis Street) will follow suit, as we had previously prepared to do in that contingency, and close its operations beginning Friday, March 13, through April 3 (the duration of the school closures).

We take this step with the health and safety of our clients, staff and the general public foremost in mind, and we thank you for your understanding and patience at this time.
